

CARPENTER

Carpenters are skilled crafts- men/women assisting the project team in duties such as framing, flooring, ceiling and window installation, siding, material setup, roofing, staging, finish work, etc. utilizing hand and power tools. Carpenters construct, install and repair structures and fixtures. Physical requirements of the job include lifting 25 pounds on a regular basis and occasionally up to 80 pounds in a safe manner, utilizing team lifting when possible.
